Entries Taken: Exhibits may be delivered to pavilion Tuesday 1 May 2.00-5.30pm or post to PO Box 126, Narrabri NSW 2390. All entries must be securely packed with suitable packing for return consignment. All return freight must be paid in advance. Exhibits will be returned as per the instructions received.

Entries Collected: Exhibits can be collected after the fireworks and by 9.00pm on Saturday 5 May from the pavilion. Any uncollected entries after that time can be collected from the Secretary's Office on Sunday 6 May between 10.00am and 4.00pm. Uncollected items will be removed from the Showground with collection within 5 days arranged with the Secretary. Unclaimed entries will be disposed of.

Entry Fees: Open Section: \$5.00 (Classes 1 – 7) Juniors: Free (unless entering in open classes)

Prizes: First, second and third prize cards and ribbons will be issued at the discretion of the judges. Ribbons and prize cards will be awarded to Champion Junior Artist and Grand Champion Open Artist. The judge may award highly commended prize cards at their discretion.

Conditions:

- An entry form must be completed for each exhibitor.
- All care will be taken but no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage.
- Exhibits must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor and have been completed within the **last 2 years**. No copies allowed.
- Exhibits must not have been exhibited at a previous Narrabri Show.
- Proof of age must be provided to the Steward upon request
- An exhibit cannot be entered in more than one class. Limit of two (2) entries per class.
- All exhibits must be **FRAMED** and **READY TO HANG** with cord or wire attached very securely to the back of framed or mounted artwork.
- The name, address and phone number of the Exhibitor and the class number must be clearly visible on the back of each exhibit.
- Exhibits may be offered for sale and must have the sale price clearly indicated on the entry form. A commission of 20% will be charged by the Society for work sold during the show.

- The organisers reserve the right to have any work reproduced by the media.
- The organisers reserve the right to withhold awarding of a prize if, in the opinion of the judge, no work of a suitable standard has been submitted.
