All competition at this show is governed by these regulations and by the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Rules for Discipline in Horse Sections at Shows which can be viewed at www.agshowsnsw.org.au. Should it become necessary for the ASC Disciplinary Committee to open an inquiry into any aspect of competition in this Horse Section, this Society will support any penalty imposed by that Committee as a result of the inquiry and will support penalties resulting from enquiries arising from Horse Sections at other NSW shows.

STABLING & CAMPING

- Stable and camping bookings can be made online at www.narrabrishow.com or via the Show Secretary.
- Straw bedding is prohibited (fine of \$1,000).
- Temporary yards are not to be erected unless the Narrabri Show Society determines that there are an insufficient number of stalls on the grounds.
- Electric cords must be tagged and covered or elevated for safety.

INDEMNITY & WAIVER FORMS

- The Horse Committee will take all care in managing the Section, but competitors taking part in this Horse Section do so at their own risk. Each adult competitor must, before competing, complete and sign a form indemnifying the Narrabri Show Society and waiving any claims against the Society for any injury sustained in competition or for loss or damage to the competitor's property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Show. A similar form must also be completed and signed by a parent or guardian for each competitor who is under 18 years of age. ALSO, on each Waiver, each horse with which the competitor is involved in competition at the Show must be listed together with **the Property Identification Code (PIC)** of the property from which the horse came to the Show.
- Waiver Forms must be signed by all competitors, including handlers, and presented to the Horse Events Tent in the Grassed Arena (map ref: O6) **prior to competing** in any horse event. We will have spare forms at the tent during the show, but competitors are encouraged to download the form from www.narrabrishow.com, print out and complete prior to the show.
- One form per family last name.
- **Please retain the issued wristband for the duration of the show.**
- Competitors are encouraged to hold their own Ambulance Cover.

HORSE SECTION REGULATIONS CONTINUED

EVENT ENTRIES

- **Showjumping and Dressage** must enter via www.narrabrishow.com by the date specified for each discipline. No on-the-day entries will be accepted for these events. When you arrive at the show, you must bring a printed receipt showing proof of payment of entries to the Horse Events Tent along with a completed waiver form, where you will be given the appropriate wristband(s).
- For **all other horse events**, competitors must present their waiver form at the Horse Events Tent in the Grassed Arena (map ref: O6) and purchase one **"STANDARD" wristband (\$15) per competitor**, which will give them entry to all horse events other than Showjumping and Dressage for the duration of the show.
- **All competitors must pay entry to the grounds.** Day passes or show memberships are available, please visit www.narrabrishow.com or contact the Secretary for details.

JUDGES

- **Judge's Decision/Discretion:** At all times the judge's decision will be final. A judge has the discretion to ask that a led or performance exhibit and handler/rider/driver be ordered to leave the ring if he/she considers the animal is unruly and/or likely to cause an accident.
- **Approaching Judges:** No exhibitor or associate will initiate conversation with a judge on judging day, before, during or after judging except through the Ringmaster or Steward.
- **Prohibited Relationship:** No competitor will present for judging before a judge with whom he/she has a family relationship, has or has recently had a personal relationship or has had horse related business dealings during the past twelve months.

GENERAL HORSE EVENT REGULATIONS

- Narrabri Show Society Committee Members, Stewards, Officials & their families are eligible to compete in any horse event.
- Narrabri Show Society will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse, rider, handler, spectator or equipment.
- The Narrabri Show Society reserves the right at their absolute discretion to alter or amend the regulations, program, prizemoney or any aspect of the event as they see fit. The most up to date program will appear on www.narrabrishow.com.
- The Ringmaster reserves the right to vary the order of events on the day to make the schedule run smoothly.
- **Refusal of Entry:** The Narrabri Show Society reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning any reason for doing so.
- **Stallions:** Stallions must be wearing a bit at all times when being led and must be under the control of a person 17 years of age or older. They must be supervised at all times and securely fastened when tied to the outside of a truck or float. They are not eligible to compete in ridden classes unless their eligibility is specifically stated in the program. Stallions are eligible to compete in **Showjumping** events.
- **Lateness to the Ring:** Competitors must be ready when called. Once judging has commenced, a competing horse shall not be led, ridden or driven into or out of the judging ring without the permission of the judge and/or steward.
- **Leaving the Ring:** If a led horse should drag or escape its handler or a ridden or driven horse take control of or unseat its rider and leave the ring, it is usually disqualified from the class.
- **Horse Measuring:** No official measuring will take place at the show, but, if a question about height arises, proof of height may be required. In the absence of proof, a decision will be at the absolute discretion of the Ring Master or Chief Steward.
- **Breed Registration:** Registration documents for horses in breed classes must be produced when required by a Steward.
- **Rider's Age** to be as at the first day of competition.

HORSE SECTION REGULATIONS CONTINUED

- **Affire:** Competitors must be appropriately attired for the competition in which they are competing.
- **Helmets:** Every rider is encouraged to wear a safety helmet compliant with the current Australian Standard. Riders under 17 years must wear such a helmet. Riders in **showjumping** events must wear a helmet compliant with Equestrian Australia rules.
- **Footwear:** All competitors must wear appropriate footwear when leading or riding a horse. When riding, the footwear must enable removal of the foot from the stirrup.
- **Cruelty:** Persons who are considered by the Ringmaster or Steward to be abusive or cruel to a horse will be expelled from the ground. No horse will be permitted to compete if, in the opinion of the Ringmaster or section Steward, it is in poor health or condition.
- **Drugs:** Drug testing may be carried out at this show. Any competitor found to have breached the ASC disputes & disciplinary regulation will be investigated by the ASC disciplinary committee."
- **Coaching:** Any person detected coaching a competitor while that competitor is being judged may be removed from the Showground.
- **Proper Conduct:** Any exhibitor or associate who behaves offensively on the Showground will be expelled from the ground, may be banned from the show in future and may be banned by other Societies.
- **Protests:** A protest or complaint against any exhibit or exhibitor must be lodged in writing and must be accompanied by a \$50 fee with the Ringmaster or section Steward no later than 15 minutes after the judging of the exhibit or exhibitor. The protest or complaint will be referred to the Protests Committee. The matter shall be dealt with by the Protests Committee within 24 hours of lodgement and the decision of the Protest Committee shall be final. If the protest is not upheld by the Protest Committee, the \$50 fee will be forfeited. No protest or complaint will be considered if it refers simply to a judge's decision.

RING EVENTS

- **Show Hunters:** Horses in these classes may not also compete in Open Hack, Galloway or Pony classes.
- **Open Hack, Galloway, Pony:** Horses in these classes may not also compete in Show Hunter classes.
- An **Intermediate** entry is any horse that has not placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a similar event at any Royal Show or Exhibition.
- A horse/pony **cannot compete in both** Childs and Adults hack classes.
- To compete in Australian Hunter & Show Horse Assoc (AHSHA) events, both rider and horse must be registered with AHSHA.

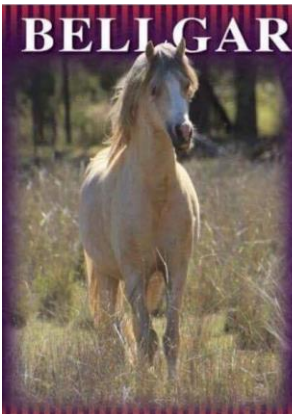
