Entries Taken: Entries must be delivered to the pavilion on Wednesday 8th April between 4.00pm-6.30pm

Theme: Beauty Within The Drought

Conditions of Entry:

- All entries (short stories included) must be relevant to the theme with exception to book studies.
- Digital presentations must be handed in on a labelled USB with a cover page that consist of the name of the school, year/class and the title of the presentation.
- Each entry must be put onto an entry form (sent out to schools).
- Proof of age must be provided upon request from the steward.
- No display board or exhibit larger the 1m x 2m.
- Students can make only one entry per class.
- Open to all students attending school or being privately taught within the Narrabri Shire or children who live within the Narrabri Shire attending boarding school.
- Each individual and school class entry **must** be bona fide work of the students.
- The work must not have been entered in a previous Narrabri Show.
- Only 10 handwriting and 10 short stories per school class in each section.
- **The name of the Student, the School, the Section name and the Section number Must be located on the entry tag on the back of all schoolwork being entered.**
- Judge's decision if final.

High School – Senior (years 10, 11 and 12)

Primary Schools – Multi Categorical K to 6

1. Class mural – no larger the 1m x 2m. Must be relevant to theme
2. Individual artwork or work samples
3. Digital presentation- PowerPoint, iMovie etc. Must be relevant to theme
4. Class book study/artwork

Upper Primary – Years 5 & 6

5. Digital presentation - PowerPoint, iMovie etc. Must be relevant to theme
6. Class mural – no larger than 1m x 2m. Must be relevant to theme
7. Class science investigation
8. Individual artwork - painting/drawing
9. Short story – up to 300 words

Lower Primary – Years 3 & 4

10. Class mural – no larger than 1m x 2m. Must be relevant to theme
11. Class science investigation
12. Individual artwork - painting/drawing
13. Short story – up to 300 words

Infants – Years 1 & 2

14. Class mural – no larger than 1m x 2m. Must be relevant to theme
15. Individual artwork - painting/drawing
16. Handwriting – 3 lines of writing ,1 line of pattern
17. Short story

Kindergarten

18. Class mural – no larger than 1m x 2m. Must be relevant to theme
19. Class book study/artwork – no larger than 1m x 2m
20. Individual artwork – painting/drawing

Pre-school/Playgroup/Sunday School

21. Class project – favourite book
22. Class mural – no larger than 1m x 2m
23. Mobile (Must be able to hold its own weight)
24. Individual artwork – painting/drawing

All school work entries MUST be collected from the pavilion on Sunday 3rd of May between 4.30pm-5.30pm.
